## **Troon Show Committee Rules & Regulations**

- Any animal or competitor found by the Committee to be behaving inappropriately will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
- Although the Committee will make every effort to avoid class clashes due to the number of classes being held clashes may be unavoidable. In that event competitors will be expected to choose which class they wish to enter. No refunds will be given but we will, where possible, change entries to another class of your choice.
- All trophy-winners will be asked to pay a one-off £10.00 refundable deposit for any trophies won on the day by one rider (ie if you win 5 trophies you will still only pay £10).
- Trophies won on 6th May 2017 must to be returned by 31st March 2018, either to Polstrong Feedstores, Pool, or Bev Knight on 07597085110.
- The judges' decision is final.
- Any complaint must be made in writing to the Secretary, Mrs S Pascoe accompanied by a cheque for £50. Complaints will be investigated in full within 20 working days.
- All competitors will park where specified by the parking attendants on the day. Failure to comply with the attendants' instructions may result in disqualification from the show.
- Stallions may not be shown in hand by any junior who has not attained their 16th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Correct British Standard headgear conforming to PAS015 or EN1384 or ASTM F1163 or current standards to be worn at all times when mounted with chinstraps fastened.
- All ridden ponies must be 4 years old and over.
- Any foals being shown must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.
- Unaccompanied Competitors must provide the Show Organiser a contact telephone number in case of an emergency.

**Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and dogs MUST be cleaned up after and disposed of correctly**

**No ring will wait longer than 5 minutes for any competitor unless agreed previously with the ring steward**

## Qualification:

### South West Pony Association (SWPA)

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships to be held from 31st August to 3rd September 2017 at the David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Gwent.

#### **To qualify for the Championships:**

Enter one of the qualifying classes;

Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring; then Complete and return the qualification card.

The following classes are qualifiers for the 2017 South West Pony Association final: 16-32, 34-36, 40-48, 53-56

### Equifest

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 9th to 13th August 2017. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

The following classes are qualifiers for the 2017 Equifest final: 18-19, 21-32, 40-42

### NPS

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show which will be held from 1st – 3rd August 2017.

**NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

**NPS Qualifying Rounds:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breders are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breders are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are

eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st -3rd August 2017

**The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.**

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

## CHAPS

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) Affiliation No: 17130 Both owners and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their value Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

**The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 31st August – 2nd September 2017. Shows held on or after the Postal Entry closing date of the Championship Show will count as 2018 qualifiers.**

The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers (18,19,24). For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook or visit [www.chapsuk.com](http://www.chapsuk.com) for rulings.

All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

## Native Pony Association of Cornwall

Open only to Pure Bred Native ponies registered with their respective Breed Society. A qualifier for the "Grand Prix Arenas Champion of Champions" Native Pony Association of Cornwall (normal rules in relation to presentation of ponies in the ring i.e. no plaiting, no spurs, length of sticks etc., to apply) and shown in their natural state. Champion of Champions sponsored by GRAND PRIX ARENAS

The Champion from classes 25-28, 29-32 plus the first and second prize winners from classes 43-44 and two riders from classes 35, 36 and 39 will qualify.

Both Champion of Champions, Young Handler and Best Rider Finals will be held at Colrairie Equestrian centre TR4 9LN on the 2nd of September 2017.

### **Class 1 - Ring 1 –Troon Unaffiliated 50cm Open Mixed (Horses & Ponies)**

Time Limit of 2 mins allowed. Fences not exceeding 50cms.Single Phase

Class qualifies for David Broome Event Centre.(Double Clear)

**Entry Fee: £8 1st to 6th Rosettes will be awarded to Horses & 1st to 6th Rosettes to Ponies**

### **Class 2 - Ring 1 –Troon Unaffiliated 60cm Open Mixed (Horses & Ponies)**

Time Limit of 2 mins allowed. Fences not exceeding 60cms.Single Phase

Class qualifies for David Broome Event Centre.(Double Clear)

**Entry Fee: £8 1st to 6th Rosettes will be awarded to Horses & 1st to 6th Rosettes to Ponies**

### **Class 3 - Ring 1 - Club Mixed 70cm (Horses & Ponies)**

Club (Single Phase). Time Allowed: 2 minutes. Start Height 70cm.

Open to non-registered or British Showjumping Club competitors, horses and ponies. Riders of any age are allowed on ponies. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes.

Qualifying period: 1st July 2016 to 30th June 2017

Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the four height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category.

Points

1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3.

Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters is eligible for points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters.

**Entry Fee = £8.00**

### **Class 4a - not before 10:30 - Ring 1 - Club - Horse 80cm**

Club (Single Phase). Time Allowed: 2 minutes. Start Height 80cm.

Open to non-registered or British Showjumping Club competitors and horses. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes.



Qualifying period: 1st July 2016 to 30th June 2017

Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the four height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category.

Points

1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3.

Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters is eligible for points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters.

**Entry Fee = £8.00**

#### **Class 4b - not before 10:30 - Ring 1 - Club - Pony 80cm**

Club (Single Phase). Time Allowed: 2 minutes. Start Height 80cm.

Open to non-registered or British Showjumping Club competitors and ponies (riders of any age can compete on ponies). Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes.

Qualifying period: 1st July 2016 to 30th June 2017

Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the four height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category.

Points

1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3.

Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters is eligible for points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters.

**Entry Fee = £8.00**

#### **Class 5a - Ring 1 - Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round**

Rule 318. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2016 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2016 (assigned for the qualifying Period).

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 85cms National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in one Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur First Round

competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in any of the Dodson & Horrell National Amateur 85cms Second Round competitions, irrespective of their placing for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191) Horses in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear in order to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the Dodson & Horrell National Amateur Championships.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £12.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £84.00.

Entry Fee = **£12.00**

### **Class 5b - Ring 1 - Senior 85cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld.

Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £12.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £84.00.

Entry Fee = **£12.00**

### **Class 6 - not before 11:30 - Ring 1 - KBIS Senior British Novice Championship – First Round/90cm Open**

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Novice:

For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular KBIS Insurance British Novice competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

90cm Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

In Category 1 Shows, in the event of 30 starters or more, the class will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows, the class must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £12.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £84.00.

Entry Fee = **£12.00**

### **Class 7a - not before 16:15 - Ring 1 - Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round**

Rule 320. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2016 (assigned for the qualifying Period). and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2016 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/ International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Second Rounds

Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in one Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur First Round competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in any of the Dodson & Horrell National Amateur 95cms Second Round competitions, irrespective of their placing for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear in order to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur First Round Competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the Dodson & Horrell National Amateur Championships.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £12.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £84.00.

Entry Fee = **£12.00**

### **Class 7b - not before 16:15 - Ring 1 - Senior 95cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses / ponies may only

compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld.  
Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £12.00, 5th: £12.00, Total: £84.00. Entry Fee = £12.00

Class 8 - Ring 1 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery –First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses / ponies may only compete in one section. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses that are five years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

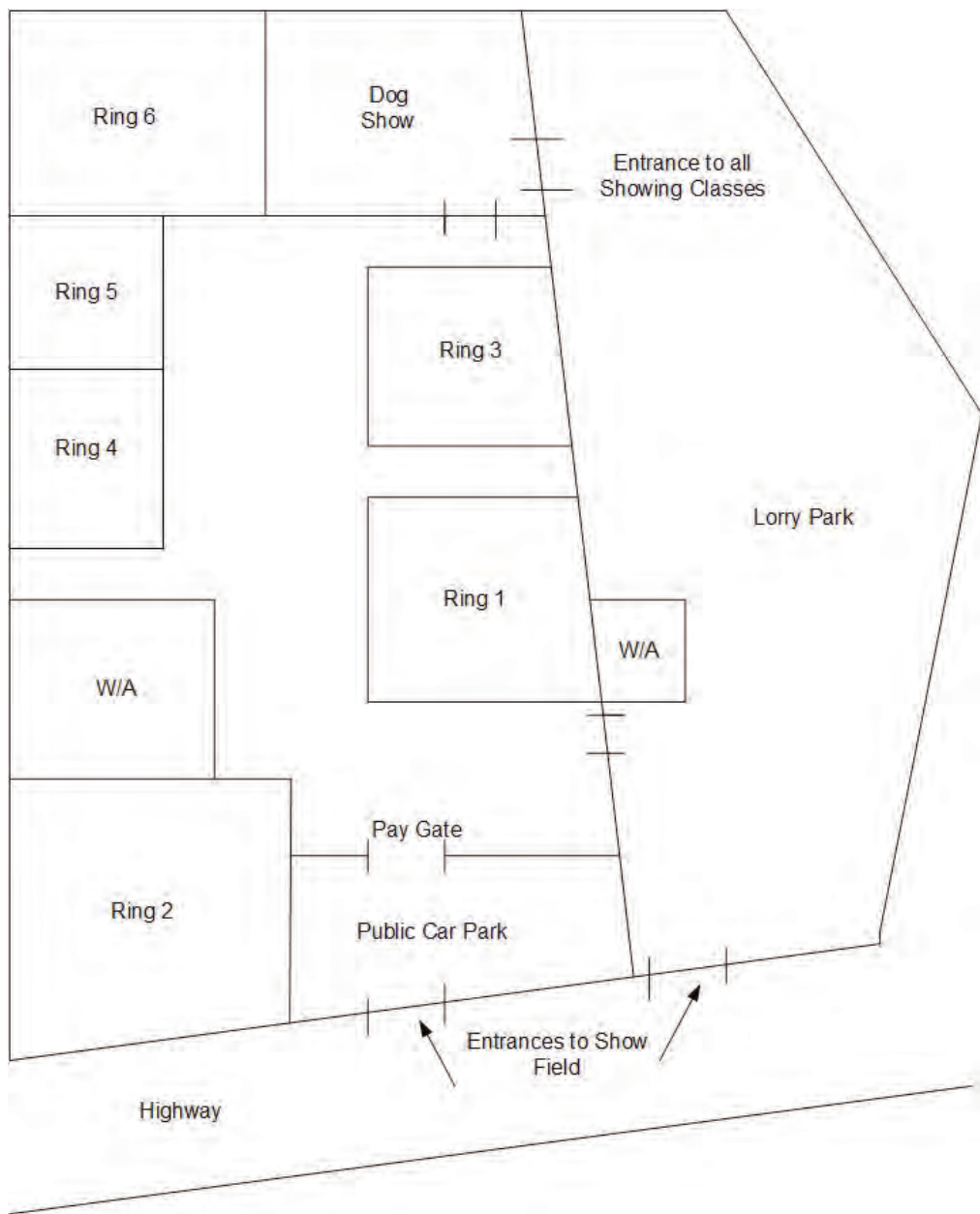

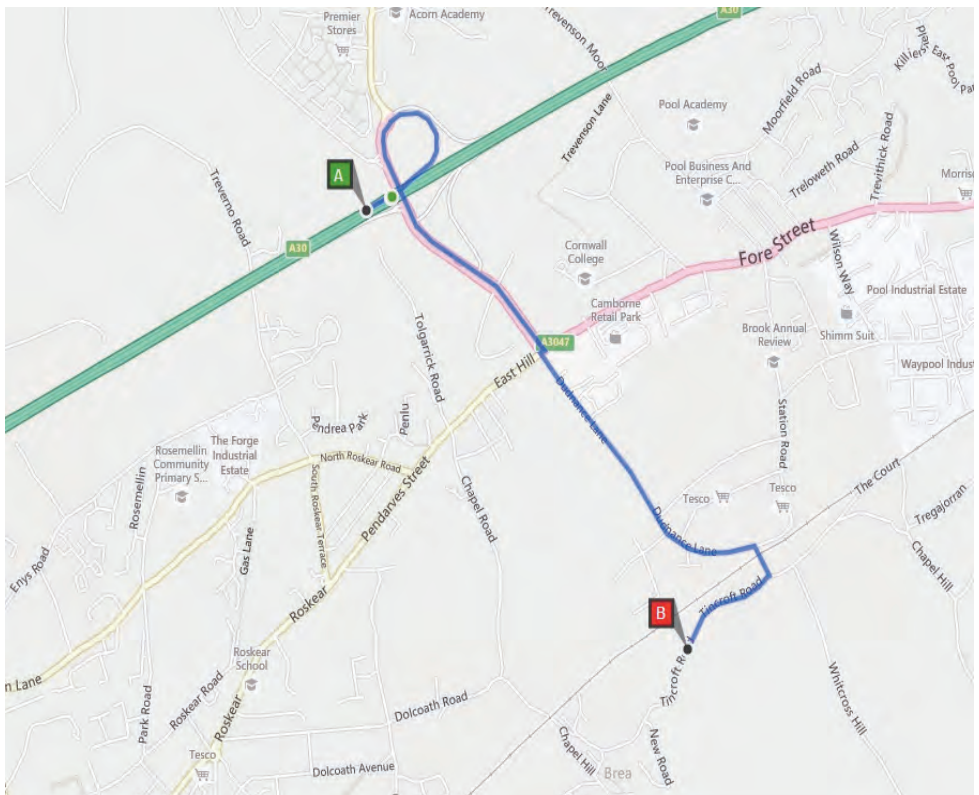

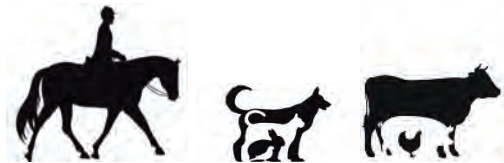
